Please Note When Making Your Travel Arrangements:

The Pilgrimage begins at **4pm on Monday 22nd July 2019** with afternoon tea and room allocation and concludes with lunch **on Thursday 1st August 2019.** Please be aware of these times when making your travel arrangements so that you can be there for the beginning and end of the Pilgrimage.

It is highly recommended to those who are making long haul flights from places such as Australia, New Zealand, Canada or the West Coast of USA that you plan to arrive in Ireland at least one or two days (*or more if possible*), to allow time for recovery from the journey before the Pilgrimage begins. It is also recommended that you avoid return flights on the day the Pilgrimage ends in order to allow time for re-orientation before the long flight home.

For those who are making more local flights such as the UK, Europe or the East Coast of USA please be aware that the coach from Tullow back to Dublin, on the last day of the Pilgrimage, will not arrive in Dublin City until approximately 4pm. Traffic to the airport at that time will be very heavy and it could take an hour or more to get to the airport from the city. It is recommended that you plan to travel later that evening or the next day to avoid possible delays and stress.

If you have any questions or concerns re these matters, please do not hesitate to contact us before you finalise your travel arrangements.
